SINGER songwriter Nikki Felle has been given the big thumbs up by judges at a national music competition.

The German-born artist who lives in Shortlands, Bromley, has been making music since she was a teenager.

The prize for the winning act will be a recording and management contract, with the potential of large investment for a single release.
